<input type="checkbox"/>	Neutral Effect	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Track Line (TL).....	2 sets of 3 vertical planes, 2 feet wide
<input type="checkbox"/>	Wide Mixed Solar Line (WMS).....	30 straight, parallel planes, equally-spaced, @ 9" intervals, moving downward in daytime
<input type="checkbox"/>	Aquastraight Line (AST) during day...	23 vertical planes, 20 ft. wide, like the night AST but all planes are beneficial
<input type="checkbox"/>	Aquastat (AS).....	4 sets of 3 vertical planes, roughly 6 ft. wide, found in groups of 3
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spring Spiral (SS).....	5 parallel, vertical planes in a tight, CCW spiral, formed by a rising water column
<input type="checkbox"/>	Magnetic Vortex (MV).....	"Tornado" of 11 concentric vertical tubes, very complex formation, common, CW spin
<input type="checkbox"/>	Electric Vortex (EV).....	Upside-down version of above with upward moving energy, common, CCW spin
<input type="checkbox"/>	Three-Ring Circle (3RC).....	3 concentric, vertical tubes, about 9 inches apart, diameter roughly 350 feet, frequent
<input type="checkbox"/>	More Beneficial	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Subtle Line (SL).....	7 vertical planes, 3 feet wide, straight
<input type="checkbox"/>	Celtic Cross Spiral Line (CCS).....	3' wide, vertical, 5-plane, spiral, moving CW or CCW, ending within ¼ mile in a tight spiral
<input type="checkbox"/>	Geodetic Line (GL)*.....	Vertical, single-plane, straight, several-hundred-foot-wide group of 11 Yin/Yang pathways
<input type="checkbox"/>	Serpent Line / Dragon Line (DL).....	21 vertical, single-plane, CW or CCW spiral, 100+ feet between planes, infrequent
<input type="checkbox"/>	Positive 4-spiral Bull's-Eye (P4B).....	Five concentric, vertical tubes with four CW and CCW spiral planes moving toward it
<input type="checkbox"/>	3-Spiral Tube (3ST).....	4-foot vertical tube feeding into three, short, CCW, 3-plane, 6-inch wide, vertical spirals
<input type="checkbox"/>	Positive Mental Line (PML).....	5 vertical planes, 1 foot wide, meandering
<input type="checkbox"/>	Aerial Grid Line (AGL)*.....	2 sets of 4 vertical AC planes astride 1 set of 4 downward-flowing, DC planes, 6' wide in total
<input type="checkbox"/>	Electromagnetic Vortex (EMV).....	Combines all features of magnetic and electric vortices, occurs in nearby pairs, rare
<input type="checkbox"/>	River Lines (RL).....	Five straight, vertical, parallel planes at an 11-inch spacing usually following a river's course
<input type="checkbox"/>	Positive Bull's-Eye Pattern (PBP).....	4 concentric vertical tubes forming a 6- to 14-foot "target" pattern
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pos. Straight Monadic Path (PSMP)...	2 parallel groups of 4 parallel, vertical planes, 19 feet between groups, 7" between planes
<input type="checkbox"/>	Celtic Cross Straight Line (CCS).....	Many parallel, vertical, 3-foot wide, straight pathways, each containing 3, 5, or 7 planes
<input type="checkbox"/>	Continental Spiral (CS).....	Very rare, 21 vertical-plane, paired CW and CCW spirals, 180-foot plane spacing
<input type="checkbox"/>	Telluric Channel (TC).....	Single vertical plane originating in an underground, low-frequency AC, or DC energy flow
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chi Lines (CL).....	Single, vertical, unidirectional plane, enters E window/door, exits W window/door
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spiral-Fed Grid (SFG).....	Four, 3-plane spirals, rotating CCW, move 16 ft. into a single-plane grid cross, 20 mi. apart
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sleep Lines (SLP).....	11 straight, N-S, equally-spaced, parallel vertical planes @ 6" spacing, only at night
<input type="checkbox"/>	Triple Spiral (TS).....	3 large, connected, 6-plane spirals in a 100 ft. triangular pattern, rotating inward and CCW
<input type="checkbox"/>	Single Oval Tube (SOT).....	Single-plane, vertical, oval tube, less than 9 feet across
<input type="checkbox"/>	Single Circle (SC).....	Single vertical tube with diameter roughly 30 feet, moves downward from above
<input type="checkbox"/>	Wide Planetary Grid Line (WPG)*...	8 or 11 vertical, parallel, nearly straight, variable-width, directional, infrequent, grid-forming planes
<input type="checkbox"/>	Blind Spring or Water Dome (WD)...	Underground pool from rising water forms vertical tube; origin of WE, AS, and AST
<input type="checkbox"/>	Most Beneficial	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Celtic Cross Circle (CCC).....	100's of vertical, concentric cylinders, formed at center cross of Celtic Cross Straight Lines

* "Ley line" can mean most anything, but the GL, AGL and WPG are the three most often referred to by this title. They differ in pattern, width, and intensity. GL lines are hundreds of feet wide and rare, AGL lines are only 6 feet wide and infrequent, and WPG lines are 29 to 42 feet wide, occurring every 123 miles (E-W lines only).
